- Teachers shoutout for coming- Hillman, Brennan, Mac. There will be more teacher involvement in PTO this year.

- School improvement plan this year is about Belonging, Empowering Educators, and Elevating Learning. The plan is presenting to the site counsel every month.

 safety risk for younger kids
